(二)洽邀廠商：請行政院公共工程委員會及財團法人中華民國對外貿易發展協會辦理洽邀廠商事宜。

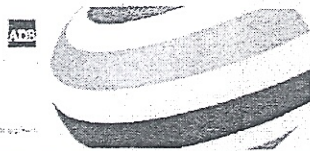
