I. Introduction

In the face of the climate crisis and increasing resource pressures, the circular economy is rapidly becoming a mainstream global strategy. The Asia-Pacific region is actively positioning itself, viewing circular economy as a core approach to advancing sustainability and enhancing the resilience of regional supply chains.

To promote a collective understanding and practical dialogue on circular economy across policy, industry, and society, Taiwan has hosted the Asia Pacific Circular Economy Roundtable (APCER) since 2019. Through this platform, Taiwan has brought together regional stakeholders and driven cross-border, cross-sector collaboration. The inaugural forum attracted over 400 participants from 18 countries, laying a solid foundation for the internationalization of Taiwan's circular economy and fostering participation from various government agencies and industry sectors.

The Circular Economy Hotspot, first launched in Europe in 2016, has evolved into a global event showcasing policy innovation and practical achievements in circular economy. In 2024, during its session in Wales, UK, it was officially announced that the Hotspot would expand to Asia and Oceania for the first time in 2025—with Taiwan successfully selected as the host. This marks the first co-hosted edition of the Hotspot and APCER.

The upcoming forum will bring together international and Taiwanese companies, policymakers, and circular economy advocates. Through public dialogue, international partnerships, and policy implementation, the event aims to transform Taiwan's circular experience into a blueprint for Asia-Pacific collaboration, accelerating the transition toward a circular economy in the region.



II. Program



The forum's thematic framework is built around the concept of the "Circular Trilogy": Good Ideas, Good Governance, and Good Business. It connects three key drivers—enterprise, national, and international levels—to ensure that the agenda is systemic, multi-layered, and aligned with policy transitions.

The sessions are organized into the following categories:

- i. Good Ideas for Circularity: focus on practical industry experiences and innovative approaches, such as agricultural bio-cycles and high-tech recycling systems, showcasing Taiwan's value as a demonstrative hub.
- ii. **Good Governance for Circularity**: addresses developments and collaborations in the realm of policy and systems, covering aspects such as legislation, recycling frameworks, carbon disclosure, and education.
- iii. **Good Business for Circularity**: explores corporate sustainability transitions, financial mechanisms, and innovative business



models—supporting the transformation of circular ideals into viable economic practices.

- iv. Some topics, such as financial facilitation mechanisms, trade and traceability, and consumer behavior, span across both governance and business dimensions, highlighting the integrated and cross-cutting nature of circular economy issues.
- v. As part of the APCER & Hotspot 2025 program, six industry-themed site visits—agriculture and food, textiles, electronics, architecture, plastics and packaging, and culture & community regeneration—will offer international participants a first-hand look at Taiwan's circular economy in action.

STEP 1

- Certificate of attendance (available after the event)
